

# VISITOR RULES

All persons entering the Blaine County Detention Center for the purpose of visiting an inmate will abide by the following rules:

1. Must be at least eighteen (18) years old or be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.
2. Must have a current valid and legal photo ID, i.e. State Drivers License, State ID card, Military ID card, Tribal ID card, or Government Agency ID card.
3. No smoking will be allowed within the Blaine County Public Safety Facility.
4. No food or beverages will be allowed in the visiting area.
5. Children will not be left unattended or allowed to be unruly.
6. No intoxicated subjects will be allowed to visit.
7. Any disruptive behavior or obscene conduct will result in termination of the visit.
8. No vulgar language will be allowed.
9. All subjects entering the Detention Center are subject to search.
10. Any subject passing or attempting to pass contraband into the Detention Center may be charged under Idaho Code 20-627.
11. No letters or correspondence for inmates will be accepted. Letters or correspondence must go through the mail.
12. All visitors will wear appropriate clothing.
13. Habitual violations of the above rules will result in you, the visitor being banned from visiting.
